CQ Press E-Journals:

CQ Researcher - The *CQ Researcher* is your complete source for in-depth analysis, reporting on the most current and controversial issues of the day. Each week, we publish an exhaustive 12,000-word report that engages with insightful, unbiased analysis of the most pressing issues in the news. (Annual subscription with rolling 10-year archive)

CQ Researcher Plus Archive - Includes all of the reports in the *CQ Researcher* subscription plus an additional back file of over 4,000 reports dating to the first Editorial Research Report published in 1923. This model is a perpetual-ownership model, where the library pays a one-time fee with lower annual renewal fees. In the event the library elects to discontinue annual updates, the library retains access to the reports in perpetuity. (One-time purchase of complete back file)

CQ Global Researcher – uses the same in-depth, single-topic structure as *CQ Researcher* and includes bi-monthly reports on newsworthy global affairs written by veteran journalists with years of international reporting experience. Other features include “Voices from Abroad” in each report. (Annual subscription)

CQ Weekly - Reports on the world’s most powerful legislative body on a weekly basis. The CQ news team – the largest on Capitol Hill – covers virtually every act of the US Congress through weekly cover stories, columns, roll call votes, analysis and more. (Annual subscription or perpetual rights; back file 1983 – present, one-time purchase)

Annual subscription with optional dataset tool that allows for quantitative analysis to be downloaded/exported (one-time fee).
