What is it? VuFind is an open-source discovery interface for libraries. It provides users with an intuitive and productive experience using features such as:

- Fast, relevancy-based keyword search results;
- Spelling corrections and did-you-mean suggestions of alternate terms;
- Links to related resources;
- Faceted browsing to easily narrow down results; and
- Tools for saving and sharing searches and records



Your users deserve the best discovery experience possible. They expect the kind of experience they get with e-commerce. Cite-this, Text-this, Email-this, Export Record and Add to Favorites are all automatic with VuFind.
