Natalie Cheetham: (16:11) Can i connect my library pinterest account to my library group page on facebook?

Sophie Brookover: (16:11) Natalie, do you have a Group or a Page on FB?

Hilary Morris: (16:11) No not now..but you can include a link to your library fan page in the bio. That's all you can do right now

Hilary Morris: (16:11) You can only connect Pinterest to admin user accounts
