

QZZR for Fun Quizzes at Your Library!

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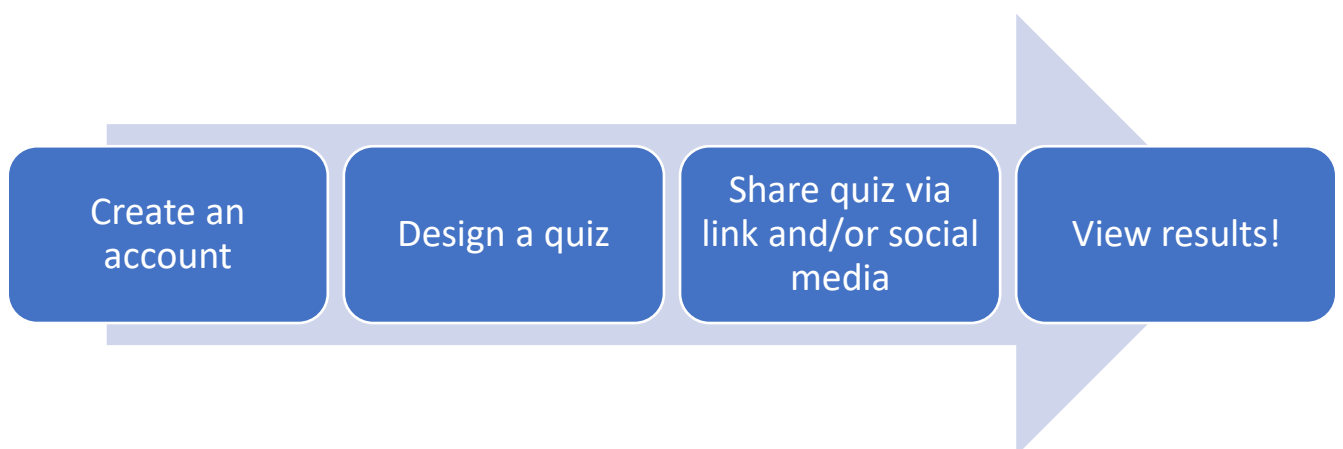
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Basic Info:

Assessment- Test your patrons or students before, during, or after a class! You can embed the link, or send a link to your students. They can see the results come in as they take the quiz, and you will have instant assessment results!
