Monthly Graph (2 Hour Average)

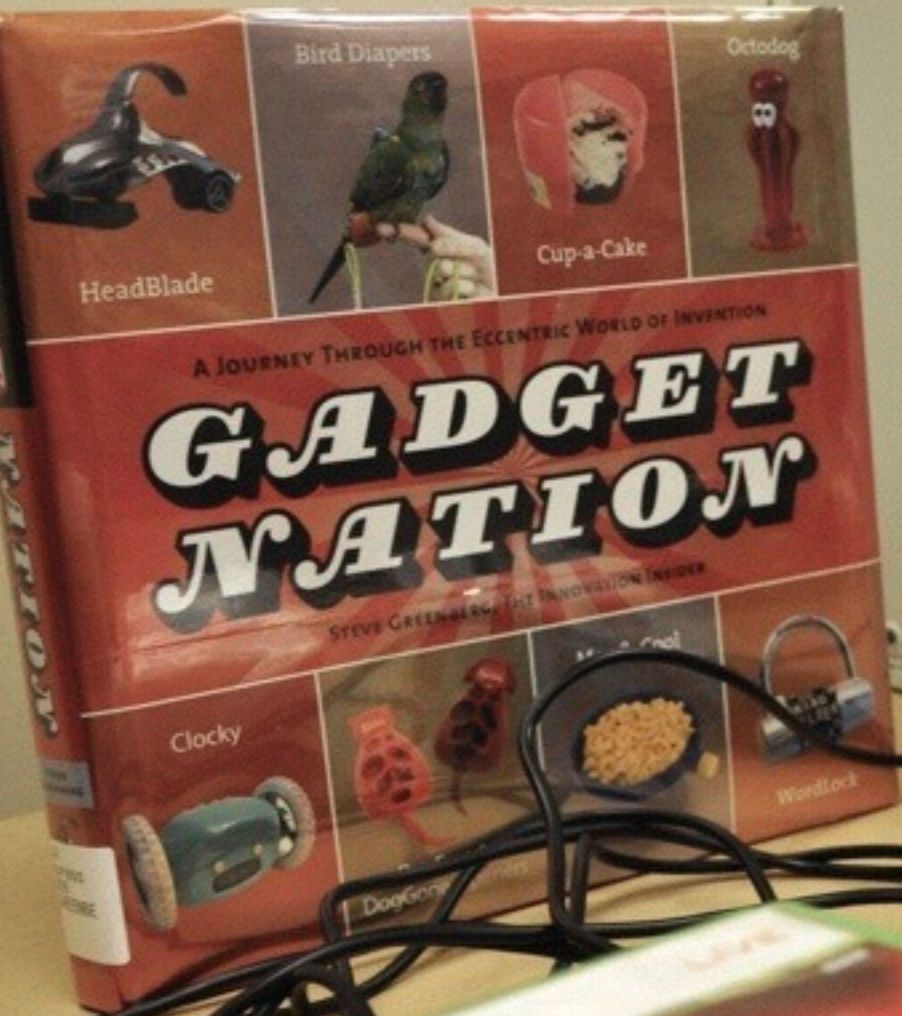
