Please Call Your Legislators Today!

Over the last 30 years, LibraryLinkNJ has been proud to provide you with a variety of services, from delivering books and materials to training library staff. It has been our honor to work with and serve all of you in this capacity.

LibraryLinkNJ is now in danger of imminent closure. We currently face a budget deficit of \$370,000. This deficit has occurred due to a variety of factors beyond our control. The cost of providing our services has increased substantially, while our state funding was cut dramatically after the Great Recession of 2008, and has remained flat ever since.

We have done everything in our power to make up this funding deficit, but our reserves have now been depleted. If we are unable to secure additional funding, we will begin the process of closing in early 2019, permanently shutting down in June. **We want to remain open.** Not just because of our personal involvement and investment in the vibrancy of library services in New Jersey, but because we recognize the undue burden this closure would place on you and the taxpayers of your community.

So we're asking for your help! Assemblymen Bob Andrzejczak (District 1) and R. Bruce Land (District 1) have just introduced a bill in the New Jersey Assembly that would provide enough funding to preserve full services via LibraryLinkNJ through the end of the current fiscal year. The bill, A-4815, must now make its way through the legislative process by January 31 if we are to save this vital organization.
