First: What About Delivery?

Statewide Delivery will continue through June 2019

New Jersey Library Network was established in 1980s

It has always been flat funded

The housing bubble burst in 2008

Strategic decision to use reserves to fund services that support the mission:

We connect all New Jersey's libraries to each other and the resources they need to serve their communities.

Triple-Whammy in FY19

- Flat-funded since FY11
- 2. FY19 commits *all* available reserves to provide service
- 3. Delivery costs increased by 45% in FY19 to true market value

Board considered income

- Cost-share employee benefits
- 2. Use all reserves
- 3. Cost-share library delivery

Board considered 3 options

Sustainable funding → Aspirational Identified \$370,000 gap

- 2. Provide only delivery → One service
- Use reserves → Dissolve Nonprofit
 Continues delivery through June 2019
 Continues CE & MentorNJ to March

State Library's Response

- Immediately identified \$85,000
 as a one-time supplement to
 LibraryLinkNJ funds for FY19 +
 an additional \$8,060 in shared
 expenses = \$93,060
- Is working with LibraryLinkNJ to find long-term solutions to provide service
