Did you know...

To ensure your child's safety and sense of security at the Monroe Township Library, we've updated our unattended child policy.

The Monroe Township Library welcomes all children to use our Library and its services, however, the responsibility for children using our space rests with the parent/guardian or assigned caregiver. Children are expected to behave in a manner conducive to maintaining an appropriate atmosphere in the building.

- Children 7 years of age or younger must be accompanied and directly supervised by a responsible caregiver who assumes full accountability for the children's safety and behavior in the Library.
- Children between the ages of 8-10 years must be accompanied by an adult or older sibling who is at least 14 years of age.
- Parents will be notified if their child is left unattended.
- If a parent or caregiver cannot be found, the proper authorities will be notified.
- The Library assumes to responsibility for children left at the Library.
- Teenagers are treated as adults. However, they are still legally the responsibility of their parents and should have an emergency contact available.
