



 A 2012 study by the CCBC (<u>Cooperative Children's Book</u> <u>Center</u>) made a startling revelation:





The <u>U.S. Census Bureau</u> released a set of estimates May 2012 showing that 50.4% of the U.S. population younger than age 1 were minorities as of July 1, 2011. A minority is anyone who is not single-race white and not Hispanic.

The population younger than age 5 was 49.7 % minority in 2011.

Diversity in children's literature isn't limited to race or ethnicity; it encompasses the inclusion of all perspectives, regardless of religious background, sexual orientation, gender, class, or disability.

We need diverse "Diverse" books.

Why Now?

Since 1985, the CCBC has compiled <u>annual statistics</u> on the status of diversity in kid lit.
